1. Upon noting that the appellant was not served to be present at today's hearing the matter is adjourned to the next Status hearing of the Court of Appeal for Grenada scheduled for 30th June 2025.
2. The Registrar of the High Court shall service a copy of this order on the appellant personally and shall provide proof of service thereafter.

Reason: The Court noted that the appellant was not served with the notice of hearing nor was he served with the record of appeal and was not present at the hearing. The Court was informed that there is some difficulty in locating the appellant. Counsel for the respondent indicated that he may be able to assist in locating the appellant. The Court therefore adjourned the matter to the next Status Hearing to attempt to serve the record of appeal on the appellant.
