IT IS HEREBY ORDERED THAT:

- 1. The Respondents shall inform the Appellant of the documents that they wish to have included in the record of appeal in accordance with rule 62.12 (2) of the Civil Procedure Rules 2000 on or before the 24th of April 2024.**
- 2. The matter is adjourned to the next Status Hearing of the Court of Appeal for the Territory of Anguilla scheduled for the 18th of November**

2024, to allow the appellant to settle his legal representation.

3. The Registrar of the High Court shall serve a copy of this order on the appellant and shall provide proof of service thereafter.

Reason:

The appellant indicated that he has collected the transcript but has not filed the Record of Appeal. He intends to get legal representation and the matter has been adjourned for that purpose. The respondent has not objected to the adjournment but has indicated that it is the position of the Crown that the matter be on the record and progressed as soon as is possible. The Court therefore granted the adjournment to the next status hearing in Anguilla scheduled for the 18th of November 2024.
