Order:** IT IS HEREBY ORDERED THAT:

1. The applicant shall provide evidence of the consent of Mr. Joseph Mathieu Rosan to the applicant proceeding on his own to represent the Estate of Charmaine Rosan-Bunbury within 14 days of the date of this order.
2. The matter is removed from the Chamber Hearing list and shall be relisted by the Chief Registrar for consideration subject to compliance with paragraph 1 of this order.

Reason: The Court noted that that the orders of the Court dated 10th July 2023, 20th July 2023 and 26th September 2023 directing the applicant to provide proof of the consent of Mr. Joseph Mathieu Rosan to the applicant proceeding on his own to represent the Estate of Charmaine Rosan-Bunbury have not been complied with.
